With this letter, I expressly endorse City Councilor John Fogle's application to continue to serve on the Intergovernmental Advisory Committee of the Federal Communications Commission (FCC).

Councilor Fogle has been a leading voice in the effort to bring high speed broadband to the City of Loveland. Established in 2018, the City of Loveland implemented its first Municipal Fiber Utility, which brought affordable, fast, and reliable internet to our 80,000 residents. Councilor John Fogle was closely involved with this effort, bringing it to fruition.
